### Update from your Parish Council.....

The Parish council has continued to work hard behind the scenes to support the local community during these difficult times.

A new Parish notice board has been installed near Woodside School. This will allow residents stay up to date with important local information.

A new children's play slide has been gifted by the Parish Council to NWBC and installed at Boot Hill play area.

A new grit salt bin has been installed to replace the damaged bin on Hastings Road.

A meeting has been held with the developers of the new development 'The Green' (Phase 2 Penmire Rise) to address concerns raised by local residents. We continue to liaise with the developers to ensure all issues are resolved.

Dordon Hall Lane – Works to the damaged road surface have been scheduled by WCC. The Parish Council continue to liaise with WCC to ensure this is completed as soon as possible.
